**PROVISION UNDER CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE :  
WOMEN**

- Section 46(4): No arrests **after sunset** (arrest in exceptional circumstances with prior permission from a Judicial Magistrate).
- Section 47(2): **Notice for search of place** (of a woman) issued by police is **not** to be issued.
- Section 164A: Doctor's Report on rape is not a conclusive proof.
- Section 53(2): **Medical Examination** by a female practitioner.
- Section 164: **Right to Privacy** while recording statement (for rape victims).
- Section 154: In categorically offences, when info FIR can be lodged which would be reduced to writing by the Police. **Time does not matter.**
- Section 160: **Attendance** can not be required at any other place.
